While The University of Texas at Austin (UT) receives many international and national visitors, it is important to note that the Research Affiliate designation is a non-compensatory assignment.

All international research affiliates are urged to attend one of the weekly orientation sessions held in the International Office (471-1211) on Monday and Wednesday afternoons from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. All J-1 Scholars must attend J-1 Scholar Orientation within 30 days of the program start date listed on the DS-2019. INSURANCE

In the interest of protecting our international students and visiting faculty, the Board of Regents requires that all J-1 visa-holders (as well as the accompanying spouse and dependents of J-1 visa-holders) be adequately covered by health insurance. Any visiting Research Affiliate, whether employed by the University or not, whose IAP-66 form for a J-1 visa has been processed by the International Office at UT is eligible for the same type of insurance as that which is available to students. The insurance program is one of the important matters covered in the orientation program for our international guests.
