## Annual Animal Usage Report: Due November 9, 2016

Each year, The University of Texas at Austin must submit an annual report of animal usage to the USDA to maintain compliance with the Animal Welfare Act. Additionally, we must also report this usage to our accrediting agency, AAALAC, to maintain our accreditation status.

These reports must include the total number of animals that have been used between October 1, 2015 and September 30, 2016. **\*\*NOTE: This is not the same reporting period as your animal use protocol(s).\*\***

All Principal Investigators that have had an active protocol in the above time period has already received an email notice regarding this report. To meet external reporting deadlines, reports **must be submitted** by 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 9, 2016.
